SELECTION CRITERIA

SAINT JOHN THE APOSTLE SCHOOL CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY

I Academic:

- . Minimum GPA allowable is 87%, or the equivalent standard of excellence.
- . No U/- or weakness determined on the academic side of the report card.
- . No "I" determined on the conduct side of the report card.
- . No "3" or below in written communication.

II Leadership:

- . Significant consideration of leadership will be considered highly important for membership selection.
- . How many leadership positions has the student attained from sixth -eighth grades both within school and outside of the school community?
- . Student must name three (3) leadership roles at school or in the community achieved since sixth grade. Indicate roles and name of the adult supervisor on the correct form.

III Service:

- . Those actions undertaken by the student that are done with or on behalf of others without any direct financial or material compensation, (in-school and within the community). This is separate from mandatory Confirmation service hours.
- . a candidate must complete a minimum of 10 service hours since the start of sixth grade.

IV Character:

- . A person of character demonstrates the following qualities: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship.
- . Student must demonstrate an outstanding record of conduct and behavior with regard to school and community rules, guidelines, and policies.
- . No "I" s or Improvement Needed on the right side of the conduct side of the report card for any category in any marking periods for the year in review.
- . All students must submit a character letter of recommendation from a source that is not academic or personal in nature, ie: parents/guardians/grandparents, etc. Sources to consider for these letters are from coaches, scout leaders, and community leaders as well.

V Citizenship:

- . Student understands the importance of civic engagement.
- . The student has a high regard for freedom and justice and respects the law for all citizens at the local, state and federal levels.
- . Demonstrates mature participation and responsibility through involvement with such activities as scouting, community organizations, or school clubs.
