



Middle School

In middle school, students begin the transition to the rigor of the high school environment. Ability-level tracking begins in the seventh grade year for language arts and math. A departmental approach is used for language arts and math, and the other major academic areas. The use of Differentiated Instruction and a rigorous core curriculum ensure that each child is fully prepared for high school. The use of Chromebooks and interactive projectors are used as tools to enhance the learning process. The integration of STEM, STEAM and Maker Space in the curriculum ensure our students are developing critical thinking skills. On a monthly basis, students participate in *Choose To Be Nice* (a Socio-Emotional Learning program.)
